Conflict Minerals Statement

In July 2010, The United States passed law H.R 4173 – Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (also known as Dodd-Frank wall street reform an consumer protection act). This legislation requires publically traded companies to disclose the presence of columbite-tantalite (coltan, niobium, and tantalum), cassiterite (tin), gold, wolframite (tungsten) or its derivatives in its product. The group of materials is better known as “conflict minerals”. Since Sigma Stretch Film supplies many publically traded companies, we are offering this statement to aid in our customer’s compliance efforts.

We confirm that no conflict minerals or their derivates are used in the production of stretch film supplied by Sigma Stretch Film.

W further confirm Sigma has complied with this regulation for the entirety of 2016.
