## **Disaster Recovery Plan**

As the industry leader; Sigma recognizes the need to protect its clients from disruptions in the supply chain. Because of this, Sigma has developed a comprehensive plan to mitigate the effects of both manmade and natural disasters.

Sigma has a strict policy against single sourcing raw materials including resins and cores. Additionally, these suppliers operate out of multiple geographic locations. This prevents a temporary disruption in one supplier or location from having a significant effect on Sigma's ability to service its clients.

Sigma has five manufacturing facilities across the U.S. and Canada that operate under the same plant operations manual. The significance of this is it allows Sigma to shift production to sister plants or ship product between them in the event of a temporary local problem. Because Sigma uses the same equipment, resins, cores, and operating procedures, the film produced at each plant is identical in quality, performance and appearance.

This plan has proven to be very effective during some of the worst natural disasters to strike the gulf coast region in recent years which resulted in extended shut downs at refineries and a temporary halt in the railway system.
