According to the European Chemical's Agency (ECHA), Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms and pose a risk to our health and the environment. They can be transported by air, water or migratory species across international borders, reaching regions where they have never been produced or used. International risk management is necessary as no region can manage the risks posed by these substances alone.

Stretch films supplied by Sigma Stretch Film are not expected to contain POPs substances. We do not specifically analyze for the presence of these substances in the product, therefore, we cannot guarantee the absence or level of these substances to any specific limit or threshold value but POPS substances are not intentionally added to resins, package, or packaging component during the manufacturing process.
